



Variation to Tower A to I Contract – Sem 2, 2020

Due to the impact of COVID-19 and the temporary closure of International House effective 9th April 2020, a variation to the Room and Board Contract for Residents for Towers A to I for Semester 2, 2020 will be implemented.

1. Effective dates for the variation of the Room and Board Contract are Sunday 3rd August until Sunday 22nd November 2020 (16 weeks). Early arrivals and late departures can be requested at an additional charge (\$55/night).
2. **The charge for the Semester 2 resident fee is \$7,680. The revised contract is to be signed and returned by Friday 26th June and payment made by 10th July to secure your room for Semester 2, 2020.**
3. Rooms have been allocated to maximize the ratio of resident to sole use bathroom (1:1) where possible.
4. Weekly linen change, rubbish removal, and bedroom and bathroom clean.
5. Meals provided are as follows:
 - a. Monday to Friday – Lunch and Dinner (2 hot options)
 - b. Saturday – Brunch
 - c. Sunday – Dinner
 - d. Packed lunches and late dinner (if required)
 - e. Dietary Requirements – catered
 - f. Bara Khanas – 2 for the semester (if possible)
6. Common rooms have been fitted out with additional equipment (refrigerators and microwaves) and utensils (cooking and eating) to allow for the preparation of other meals. Tower groupings are encouraged to remain in these groups for meal preparation and consumption (Towers B, C, D, E, G, H and I to use their common rooms; Tower A to join Tower B and Tower F to join Tower E).
7. An IH COVID-19 Policy with related plans and procedures will apply and must be adhered to at all times. These involve specific protocols about social distancing



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- (signage, common rooms, dining hall, Ivor Cribb, G Lawn); hygiene practices (hand sanitizing and hand washing); cleaning regimes (touch points, sole use bathrooms, common rooms); dealing with illness (temperature testing, non COVID-19 illnesses, testing for COVID-19, contact tracing and positive COVID-19 cases).
8. All residents are encouraged to download the COVID Safe App and to have their Flu Vaccination. The procedures for a resident who becomes ill must be followed.
 9. Visitors to college are to be kept to a minimum and must sign the visitor register (name, address, email and mobile) for possible contact tracing.
 10. UQ Lifestyle package – Gym and Pool membership has been cancelled for Semester 2, 2020.
 11. Academic Support or tutorials will be provided on-line and/or face to face to support resident requests.
 12. Pastoral Support – Senior Residents will be available to attend to resident needs out of hours as well as to deal with emergencies; additional support will be provided by the Deputy Director and Director as needed. Counselling Services provided by UQ and other providers are available upon request.
 13. Events and Activities organized by IH, IH Student Club and ICC will have to ensure that they comply with current government and health regulations in terms of social distancing, numbers permitted, type of approved activity. All events and activities must adhere to the IH COVID-19 Policy.
 14. For the well-being of all staff and residents, failure to follow instructions provided by staff or failure to implement appropriate COVID Safe measures will be deemed a breach of the Resident Code of Conduct.

It is understood that the above content may change as COVID-19 restrictions ease or if additional measures are needed to be put in place. This variation only applies to Semester 2, 2020.
